

ONIX for Books codelists Issue 65

This is the consolidated list of agreed additions and updates for Issue 65 of the ONIX for Books codelists, published in late March 2024. This set of proposals was circulated for comment to the ONIX national groups and direct to EDItEUR members who subscribe to the member-news-from@editeur.groups.io mailing list (since they may not all be in touch with a national group). Feedback was received by EDItEUR from national groups and members and any comments and issues raised were resolved prior the meeting of the ONIX International Steering Committee held during the London Book Fair. The steering committee ratified the changes.

Note the schedule for Issue 65 was unusually short due to the early March date of London Book Fair.

Code	Label	Note
11	CPV	Common Procurement Vocabulary (2008), uses to describe products and services for public tendering and procurement within the EU. Code is a nine digit number (including the check digit), and may also include a space plus an alphanumeric code of two letters and three digits (including the supplementary check digit) from the Supplementary Vocabulary. Code	Label	Note
A28	Interpreted through	Use with narratives drawn from an oral tradition, where no 'ownership' of the narrative is claimed. See also B33. Only for use in ONIX 3.0 or later
B32	Translation revised by	Where possible, also use B06 for the original translator. Only for use in ONIX 3.0 or later
B33	Transcribed by	As told to. Use with narratives drawn from an oral tradition, and with B03 (Retold by), B07 (As told by) or A28 (Interpreted through). Only for use in ONIX 3.0 or later

It need not have a hierarchical relationship with title elements at other levels, in particular with master brands. Used primarily for comic books, but applicable to other fiction where appropriate

20	ODRL	Open Digital Rights Language (ODRL) in JSON-LD format. Used for example to express TDM licenses using the W3C TDM Reservation Protocol

List 263 – Prize identifier type

Code	Label Note
01	Proprietary

Added to support a new <PrizeIdentifier> composite in a forthcoming minor revision of ONIX (version 3.1.1). A new <PrizeIdentifier> composite will support clarity in the identification of literary and other prizes – particularly in the face of name changes caused by changes in sponsorship of the prize itself.

In addition to the above, a set of proposals for additions to List 219 – Rights type – remains under discussion with rights specialists.
